CDL Driver (Commercial Driver's License)

WHAT YOU'LL DO

Drive big trucks and deliver goods across town or across the country

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be at least 18 for intrastate driving, 21 for interstate
- Commercial Driver's License (CDL), which can be earned in 4-8 weeks through a certified training school



AVERAGE YEARLY PAY:

(experienced drivers can earn more with bonuses and mileage pay)



AVERAGE YEARLY PAY:

depending on experience and location

Diesel Mechanic

WHAT YOU'LL DO

Troubleshoot engines, handle repairs, and keep vehicles running safely and efficiently

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- High school diploma or GED
- Certification from a trade school or community college (6-12 months)

Dock Worker / Freight Handler

WHAT YOU'LL DO

Load and unload trucks, organize freight, and help keep the supply chain moving

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- High school diploma or GED
- Forklift certification (often provided on the job)
- Ability to lift 50+ lbs and work in a fast-paced environment

Supply Chain Management

WHAT YOU'LL DO

Plan and coordinate the movement of goods from factories to stores

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- Associate's degree or certificate in supply chain, logistics, or business (1-2 years)
- Computer and communication skills and strong organizational ability
