FLATBED/LOAD SECUREMENT:

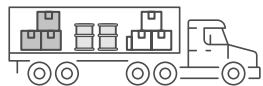
This type of freight uses open trailers to transport large or irregularly shaped items, and it's important to secure loads properly to keep them safe during travel.



FINAL MILE:

Final mile freight is the last part of the delivery journey, often using smaller vehicles to deliver goods directly to homes or businesses.

LTL (LESS-THAN-TRUCKLOAD)



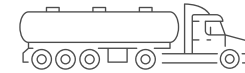
LTL freight combines smaller shipments from various customers into one truck, making transportation more efficient and cost-effective.



ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES:

This freight includes transporting waste or recycling materials using special trucks or equipment, ensuring these materials are processed or disposed of safely.

TANKER/HAZMAT:



Tanker and hazardous material freight involves transporting liquids or dangerous substances with special safety measures to protect people and the environment.

CRANE & SPECIALIZED RIGGING:



This type of freight includes moving large, heavy objects using cranes and special equipment to lift and secure them during transportation.

FOOD DISTRIBUTION:



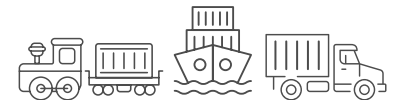
This freight moves perishable foods using refrigerated trucks to keep them fresh and safe for consumption as they travel from suppliers to stores.
